

Team members schedule medical appointments (1,980 in 2019 alone!), transport and accompany people to appointments, advocate for consumers with medical personnel during appointments, make wellness visits for medical issues, administer medications, inoculations, and some testing as well as providing medical training to staff and staffing the on-site clinic during regular business hours. 
